Yay! The growing season is here! The 2021 season brings new plans. This work in progress, is open to your suggestions, ideas and feedback.

- Our gardening days and times have changed with Tuesday evenings alternating with Saturday mornings from May through September. We hope this will allow more people to join us for a session. Below is the 2021 schedule with 2 sessions a month. Weather reschedule dates will most likely happen.
- We are developing a new program, Native Plant Gardening Learn-Along. This is a mentoring opportunity where people newer to native plant habitat gardening can learn-alongside an experienced gardener with a couple of others. We'll do the gardening chores that present themselves that week plus learn more about the plants and animal visitors (usually very small) we encounter. - Free milkweeds and other native plants will be made available.
- There is a choice for experienced gardeneers that prefer the informality of our usual semi-guided gardening sessions, to continue gardening as in previous years. The NN Gardeneers, for instance, includes seedling tree and Creeping Charlie removal specialists, whose diligent work and company is much appreciated.
