IMPORTANT NOTES ON COLLECTION FLATS

Each collection has been designed with species appropriate to the garden conditions and habitat values listed.

Each flat includes 8 species of plugs, one 6-pack each, with a total of 48 plants.

Each flat has been designed to cover about 50 square feet, depending on the flat selected.

Plants should be spaced 12-18 inches apart, as most will spread out as they mature.

A good rule of thumb:
One plant per square foot.

**Species in Collection Flats
may be substituted with
appropriate alternatives
if there is a crop failure.**
