## **UPDATED 2022 Nokomis Naturescape Gardeneer**



#### Hello Gardeneers,

Yay! The 2022 growing season is here! We'll begin gardening in May this year. This calendar is a work in progress but the dates are accurate. We'll again focus our efforts on the Boulevard Garden. one of the three NN demonstration gardens. The photo above is of the Lakeside.

- Our gardening focus is on the Boulevard Garden and corners of the two adjacent demonstration gardens (Lakeside and Hillside). The Minneapolis Park and Recreation Board are the main stewards of the Lakeside and Hillside Gardens
- Our gardening days and times are Tuesday evenings alternating with Saturday mornings from May through sometime in October. The schedule has one week "off" between the gardening sessions. We hope this will allow more people to join us for a session. Below is the 2022 schedule with 2 sessions a month. Weather reschedule dates will most likely happen and be scheduled close to original date.
- We encourage you to **Adopt-a-Pocket Garden** or be a **Species Specialist** within the Naturescape. Experienced gardeneers that prefer the informality of our usual semi-guided gardening sessions, can maintain their special spot on our scheduled times or choose a time that works best for them. Also, some gardeneers may like to choose a maintenance speciality such as removing Creeping Charlie or tree seedlings, and do with us or on their own time. The Stewardship Coordinators can talk individually with those interested in these options.
- Last year we began a new program, the **Native Plant Gardening Learn-Along**. This is a mentoring opportunity where people newer to native plant habitat gardening can learn-alongside an experienced gardener with a couple of others. We'll do the gardening chores that present themselves that week plus learn more about the plants and animal visitors (usually very small) we encounter. Learn-along the growing season topics will be presented at the beginning of each session. These 15-30 minutes presentations will then be followed by hands-on gardening time.
- The **Habitat Garden Table**, with a naturalist advisor, will be set up for each gardening session. Free milkweeds and other native plants will be made available.
